## NOTICE OF RACE

The Organizing Authority is the Racing Committee of the National Yacht Club (NYC).

### ● RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

1.2 The prescriptions of Sail Canada will apply and a copy will be posted on the Official Notice Board.

1.3 In case of differences between this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions will apply.

### 2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 The regatta is open to Alberg 30 one design boats.

2.2 Eligible boats may enter by registering by emailing [marc.decorete@rogers.com](mailto:marc.decorete@rogers.com)

2.3 Late entries may be accepted solely at the discretion of the Race Committee.

2.4 As a condition of entry, each owner or charterer and individual participating crew shall sign a liability waiver. The liability waiver form shall be submitted prior to racing at check in. The liability waiver form will be available at check in.

### 3 FEES

The fee for entries is \$20 and will be collected at sign in on June 23, 2018.

### 4 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

4.1 There will be minimum 2 races on Saturday and 1 on Sunday.

## **5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The sailing instructions will be available at the National Yacht Club at check in. Amendments to the Sailing Instructions and Notices to Competitors will be posted on the Official Notice Board.

## **6 THE COURSE**

The course will be windward/leeward drop-mark courses located southwest of Toronto Island.

## **7 SCORING**

Each team's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races. One (1) race will constitute a series. This changes RRS A2.

## **8 ARBITRATION**

For a protest between two boats alleging a breach of a rule of Part 2 or Rule 31, an arbitration hearing may be held.

## **9 IDENTIFICATION**

Competitor's yacht shall only display the sail number that is assigned by the Race Committee.

## **10 DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS**

Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around keelboats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the regatta.

## **11 RADIO COMMUNICATION**

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

## **12 PRIZES**

The Prizes include the Syronelle Trophy, a keeper trophy, in addition to first, second, and third flags.

## **13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

## **14 INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
